

**CONSTRUCTION BEGINS MONDAY, OCT. 5, 2020 ON MARBLE-ARNO STORMWATER PUMP STATION AND DETENTION POND**  
Project expected to last about 15 months, through late 2021

**About the Project**

The project is intended to address flooding issues in the Broadway Blvd./Lomas Blvd. area and historic Martineztown neighborhood through:

- A new, modern pump station; and
- A new, larger stormwater detention pond.

It will also provide improvements including:

- New sidewalks and ADA ramps;
- New water and sanitary sewer lines; and
- Attractive perimeter walls around the pump station to add to the neighborhood's history and character.



AUI is the contractor for the project. Regular work hours are **Monday-Friday from 7 a.m.-5 p.m.**, although the contractor may work longer hours or on weekends as needed. All construction is weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.

**Traffic Impacts**

**Beginning Monday, Oct. 5 and lasting through early January 2021, Arno Street will be closed to thru traffic from north of Lomas Blvd. to south of Marble Ave. Local traffic only will be allowed.** Traffic can use Marble Ave., Broadway Blvd. or Lomas Blvd. as detours.
