

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – Right-Hand Lane of Westbound Lomas Blvd to be Closed beginning Oct 7, 2021, for about 4 Weeks

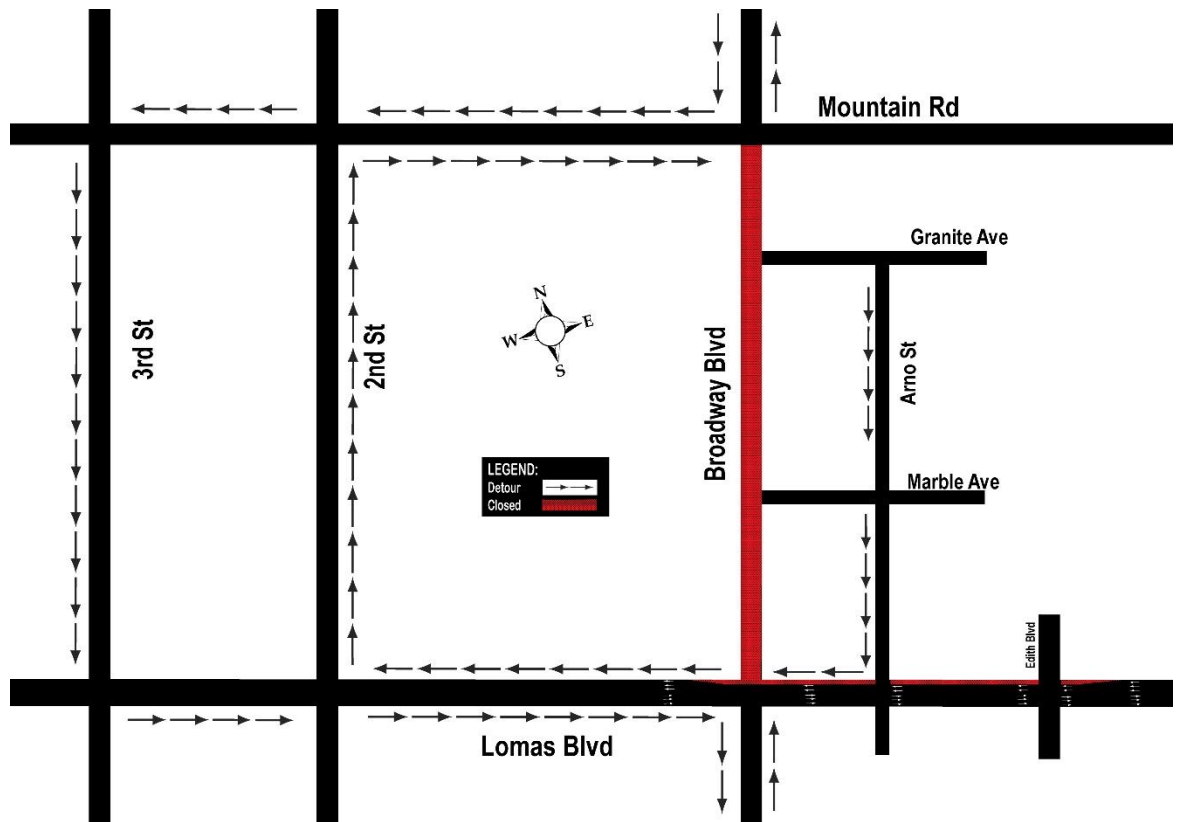

NEW: Beginning Thursday, October 7, 2021, and lasting for about four (4) weeks, through about November 4, 2021, the right-hand lane of westbound Lomas Blvd will be closed from west of Edith Blvd to just west of Broadway Blvd so crews can work on an underground vault that is part of the project. Two lanes of traffic will remain open on westbound Lomas Blvd and westbound traffic will be able to turn right and head north on Arno Street during this work.

CONTINUING: Broadway Blvd remains **COMPLETELY CLOSED** from north of Lomas Blvd to south of Mountain Rd. This closure has been extended due to the discovery of unmarked underground utility lines and other unforeseen circumstances.

The access to Starbuck's and Carl's Jr. is from Arno St just north of Lomas Blvd.



Crews are working extended hours Monday-Saturday from 6/7 a.m.-4/6 p.m. to get the construction on Broadway Blvd completed as quickly as possible.

When possible, the contractor will allow access to the U.S. Post Office from Mountain Rd to Broadway Blvd. The contractor will maintain access to businesses and residents.

DETOUR (See Map Above): Southbound traffic on Broadway is detoured west on Mountain Rd, then south on 3rd Street, then east on Lomas to access Broadway. Northbound traffic on Broadway is detoured west on Lomas, then north on 2nd Street, then east on Mountain Rd to access Broadway.

AUI is the contractor for the project.
